# FROM PASTOR BRIAN

This month is an exciting adventure as we begin a new ministry at church called "Calvary at Home". You have been hearing about it and we have been preparing for it for a long time. Now it's time to start on the road to a stronger spiritual life and a greater relationship with fellow believers. Calvary at Home combines the verse-by-verse Bible teaching that we have at Calvary, with small group fellowships across town. You will see a notice board at each of our sites with the information you will need to join a Calvary at Home group near you. Alternatively, you can talk to one of the pastors or ministry leaders that are always sitting at the back table in the sanctuary for more information.

Missions is always ON at Calvary. This month we are sending out short term missionaries to Arua and Nebbi. You may be thinking, "Haven't we done enough missions already?!" While it is true that we have gone on quite a few mission trips last year, and have already gone on two this year, we will not have

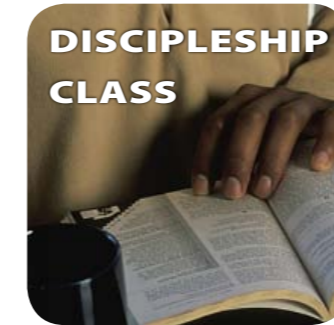

# BELIEF

**The Bible**, including both the Old and the New Testaments, is the Word of God, verbally inspired by the Holy Spirit and without error in the original manuscripts.

**God** has revealed Himself as Trinity in unity, Father, Son, Holy Spirit, three Persons and yet but one God.

**Jesus Christ** is God's only Son, deity. He was born of a virgin, lived a sinless life, died a substitutionary atoning death, resurrected bodily, ascended into heaven, and will return personally and visibly to earth.

**Holy Spirit** has come to convict the world, and to regenerate, indwell, sanctify, and empower in ministry all who believe in Jesus Christ.

**People** are separated from God and responsible for their sin, but salvation is offered to all by the grace of God. When a person repents and trusts Jesus Christ to save, s/he is born again, forgiven, and destined for heaven.

**Church** is the living spiritual body of Jesus Christ, of which He is the head and in which all believers are members.

**Resurrection** of both the saved and the lost will take place in the future. The saved will rise unto eternal life and the unsaved unto eternal damnation.

**Rapture** of the church will take place prior to the Tribulation, and the literal return of Christ with His saints to rule the earth during the Millennium.

**Love** is greater than our differences, and the only basis of Christian fellowship. Without love we have no right to claim ourselves Christians.
